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Flobo Floppy Bad Sector Repair Thanks a lot, I didn't know about the tools. Did it work for the bootable floppy? Thank you. Flobo Floppy Bad Sector Repair Flobo Floppy Bad Sector Repair does exactly what the name says: it can repair bad sectors on a floppy disk. The program has two modes: read mode and write mode. Read mode just reads and writes data and fixes the bad sectors. Thank you for your reply. Did you try the floppy repair? It worked for me, I think you have to remove the floppy to make it work. Good news: I have fixed the root problem. I took a look to the tables in the root.img file. You can see the sectors with their position. Sectors with different position are between 255-1023 (sector 0 is 256). The easiest way to check if a sector is the boot sector is to open it in a hex editor (like notepad) and look at the first 4 bytes. A valid boot sector should have a boot signature of 0xAA55. If you see a boot signature of 0xAA55 it should be bootable, but that's all. If you see something else, such as 0x0102 for example, that's the signature of the file, not the boot sector. It's easy to spot since the boot sector starts at 0x100,

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while a normal file starts at 0x01. I've checked with the floppy repair that I mentioned in my first post. It's a freeware. You can repair a floppy with this tool in three different modes: read only, read and write, or write only. This does not work with a bootable floppy. Because the floppy has the boot sector in the first sector, it is not possible to repair a boot sector in the same floppy. If you have a floppy with bad sectors, it may be useful to check if the sectors in the root.img are not too bad or if you need to restore them. Thank you 82157476af

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
